Applications will be accepted April 15 to May 15 of 2025 Please do not apply earlier than the date stated.

Bursary Applicant Eligibility

- Dependent (17-25) of current 5167 member in good standing at the time applications are being excepted.
- Current 5167 member in good standing at the time of application, returning to full time approved post secondary institution.
- Starting or returning full time to a Ministry of Education approved post secondary institution.
- Provide verification of dependent status and/or fall enrollment.

Application Process

- Each applicant may submit 350-500 word or 2-minute video submission answering the following question:
- Why are unions important, what examples do you see in your family and community?
- Email bursaries@cupe5167.org The email will be live April 15, 2025
- The applications will be numbered, and identity will not be provided to the Bursary Committee.
- 3 applicants will be selected and bursaries presented at June GMM
